6 CONSULTATION

6.1 Overview

- 6.1.1 This Chapter of the Environmental Statement (ES) provides an overview of the consultation undertaken in respect of the EIA and the wider hybrid planning application.
- 6.1.2 Consultation on the Proposed Development commenced with submission of a request for pre-application advice to Cardiff Council regarding the hybrid planning application in May 2021.
- 6.1.3 The Scoping Report (Appendix 5.1) formed the basis of a request for a formal Scoping Opinion from Cardiff Council, seeking agreement on the proposed scope of the EIA in June 2021.
- 6.1.4 The Joint Applicant has a Planning Performance Agreement (PPA) in place with Cardiff Council. The PPA has provided an opportunity for improved communication between the Joint Applicant and the Council as work has progressed towards the submission of the hybrid planning application. As part of the PPA, the Joint Applicant has sought further technical consultation with relevant Council officers, as appropriate, in relation to the proposed scope of the EIA to ensure the assessment work being undertaken was considered robust.
- 6.1.5 The Joint Applicant has also undertaken consultation with the public via a series of community consultation events, held as webinar sessions due to COVID-19 restrictions. These presentations have covered the topics of the Atlantic Wharf, Butetown Masterplan, Cardiff Arena and Hotel design, and operating the Arena.
- 6.1.6 The Joint Applicant has also created a scheme-specific website (www.atlanticwharfcardiff.co.uk). This has been used as a tool to communicate the illustrative masterplan proposals and has also included a questionnaire for visitors to complete. To date the site has received over 9,700 hits and 827 completed questionnaires have been returned. The data from these completed questionnaires has been taken into account during the design development process.
- 6.1.7 Prior to submission of the hybrid planning application, and as set out for projects comprising 'major development' in the Planning (Wales) Act 2015, a statutory preapplication consultation (PAC) will be undertaken, for a period of 28 days. The PAC will

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be informed by the documentation produced for the hybrid planning application submission, including this Environmental Statement.

6.1.8 Details of all consultations undertaken with regard to the EIA are reported in the relevant technical chapters of the ES. Table 6.1 provides a summary of the consultation to date relevant to the EIA more generally.
